**THE GRAPEVINE ADOPTED
AS NATIONAL PERIODICAL,
WILL BE MADE LARGER**

Beginning with the December issue, four more pages will be added to *The Grapevine* to allow for additional features, and letters and contributing articles from A.A.s throughout the country.

The enlargement is in line with the adoption of *The Grapevine* as the national A.A. periodical, as announced in the recent letter from Bill W. to the secretaries of the more than 600 A.A. groups.

Following expansion of the size of *The Grapevine* and because of increasing overhead due to mounting correspondence and other clerical details, the subscription rate will be raised to \$2.50 per year and 25 cents per copy, beginning with the January, 1946, issue. This rate was decided upon to assure financial security and independence for future operations. Subscriptions received up to December 15 of this year will be accepted at the old rate.
